

Dear Visitor

It is in all our interests to maintain reasonable standards of dress in keeping with national golf traditions and West Derby Golf Club wishes to preserve a "smart but casual" approach based on clothing that is principally designed for golf. As, however, dress sense is a highly subjective topic, the club would appreciate your support in maintaining the following standards of dress:

Any type or colour of denim jeans, paramilitary style camouflage trousers, tracksuits, leggings and shell suits, Collarless T-shirts, rugby and football shirts are not permitted in the clubhouse or on the course at any time. 'New style' tailored golf trousers, some with thigh pockets, are acceptable.

Shorts: Tailored shorts may be worn at any time, but men are required to wear either long socks of any colour or predominantly white short socks.

Shirts: For men, shirts without collars are not deemed appropriate; and all shirts should be tucked into trousers or shorts, unless specifically designed as over shirt. 'New style' round/crew neck golf shirts are acceptable.

Shoes: Trainers are not considered appropriate on the course or clubhouse. Golf shoes must be worn on the course and are not acceptable in the lounge, casual (golfers) bar or dining room.

Male members and guests may wear coloured knee length or short white golf socks

Caps: Caps should not be worn the wrong way round (i.e. peak at the back), and should not be worn in the Clubhouse.

Dining Room: A jacket and tie is required after 6pm unless otherwise stipulated. At all other times, smart casual attire is appropriate.

The clubhouse has every facility required for changing into and from golfing apparel. Changing in the car park is not permitted.

The implementation of this dress code is primarily the responsibility of the Management and Professional of the Golf Club. It is expected that implementation of this code will be effected with courtesy and common sense - especially as regards to guests and visitors but those who knowingly disregard it may be asked to leave or not enter certain areas of the club or clubhouse.
